Prizes will be distributed from 4.00p.m on Sunday 18th June, 2017.

Exhibits must be removed from the Marquee between 6.00p.m and 7.00p.m on Sunday 18th June, 2017.

ROSES

- 600 One Rose H.T. any colour.
- 601 Three stems of Floribunda, each different
- 602 Three stems of H.T., different colours.
- 603 One Full Blown Rose
- 604 One Miniature Rose Bush. Any colour. Pot not to exceed 23cms (9").
- 605 Three stems of Climber or Rambler Rose, same variety

FRUIT & VEGETABLES

- 606 Rhubarb - Six Stalks
- 607 2 x Heads of Table Cabbage (Not to exceed 12")
- 608 Collection of Vegetables to be displayed on a 60cm x 60cm base.
- 609 6 x Potatoes, round shaped
- 610 Lettuce - roots still on
- 611 Strawberries - 10 in a dish
- 612 Blackcurrants - 15 in a dish.

FLOWERS & SHRUBS

- 613 Sweet Pea, Five stems.
- 614 Mixed Perennials. Four stems, each different.
- 615 Lilies. Three stems.
- 616 Three stems of garden flowers, each different.
- 617 Alpines. Three stems, each different.
- 618 Three stems of Hardy Flowering Shrubs/Trees.
- 619 Three stems of Evergreen foliage, each different.
- 620 Three stems of your favourite shrub, foliage or flowering

BEGINNERS (Confined to Exhibitors who have not won a 1st prize at an Open Show)

- 626 An Exhibit using five flowers. Space allowed 46cm (18") wide

INTERMEDIATE (Confined To Exhibitors who have not won more than two 1st prizes at an Open Show)

- 627 An Exhibit featuring a Basket. Space allowed 51cm (20") wide
- 628 "Following Tradition". An Exhibit. Space allowed 80cm wide.

OPEN

- 629 'The Beauty of foliage'. An Exhibit suitable for a hall table. Space allowed 60cms.
- 630 "Still Life". An Exhibit. Space allowed 76cm (30") wide
- 631 "Simplicity". Petite exhibit not exceeding 25cm (10") in width, depth and height.
- 632 'His' & 'Hers' Buttonholes
- 633 "In to the Future". An Exhibit. Space allowed 76cm (30") wide

CHILDRENS

- 634 "A Rock, Bog or Novel Garden.". An Exhibit on a tray. Max Size 60cms square. (Confined to those under 13 years of age on Jan 1st, 2017)
- 635 "A Rock, Bog or Novel Garden.". An Exhibit on a tray. Max Size 60cms square. (Confined to those over 13 years and under 16 years of age on Jan 1st, 2017)
- 636 "A Creature". An Exhibit made from fruit and/or vegetables displayed on a biscuit tin lid. (Confined to those under 16 years of age on Jan 1st, 2017.)
