RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES

RING 1 STARTING AT 10.30am

- 1 JUNIOR SIDE SADDLE SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 153cms and under to be ridden by riders that have attained their 8th birthday but have not attained their 19th birthday on 1st January.
- 2 OPEN 123cms RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 123cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 11th birthday on 1st January.
- 3 SHOW HUNTER PONY STARTER STAKES, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 12th birthday on 1st January.
- 4 OPEN 133cms RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 123cms but not exceeding 133cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 14th birthday on 1st January.
- 5 OPEN 143cms RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 17th birthday on 1st January.
- 6 OPEN 153cms RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 20th birthday on 1st January.
- 7 OPEN INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms, but not exceeding 158cms, and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 25th birthday on 1st January

LEAD REIN & FIRST RIDDEN

RING 2 STARTING AT 11.00am

- 9 OPEN LEAD REIN SHOW PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 123cms. Riders must not have attained their 8th birthday on 1st January.
- 10 NOVICE LEAD REIN PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cms.
- 11 OPEN LEAD REIN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 123cms. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January. Riders in this class may not compete in any other class at the same show on the same day
- 12 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN PONY mares & geldings 4 years old under over, 122cms and under, suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 9th birthday on 1st January, 2017.
- 13 OPEN FIRST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONY, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 123cms suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 10th birthday on 1st January. Ponies must be shown in single ring snaffle bridle.
- 14 FIRST YEAR FIRST RIDDEN PONY for mares or geldings, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 123cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday on 1st January of the current year and must be in their first year in First Ridden Classes of any category. Riders in this class may not compete in any other class at the same show on the same day with the exception of Lead Rein Classes.
- 15 OPEN FIRST RIDDEN SHOW PONY mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, not exceeding 123cms suitable for and to be ridden by riders who have not attained their 10th birthday on 1st Jan. Ponies must be shown in single ring snaffle bridle. No Cantering except for individual performance. Ponies must leave the ring at walk or trot.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP

For 1st & 2nd Prize Winners in Classes 2, 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 & 64

- 16 YOUNG HANDLER CLASS for ponies 4-year-old and over to be shown in hand by children aged between 7 & 13. Handlers must wear the correct jacket for their chosen category including the recommended hat. Ponies in this class must also have been entered in their riding class at Show on the same day.
- 17 YOUNG HANDLER CLASS For ponies 4 year old and over to be shown in hand by children aged between 14-17. Handlers must wear the correct jacket for their chosen category including the recommended hat. Ponies in this class must also have been entered in their riding class at the Show on the same day.

PONY BROOD MARE AND YOUNGSTOCK INHAND

- 20 SHOW PONY, colt, filly or gelding, yearling, likely to make a Show Pony, to be shown in hand.
- 21 SHOW PONY, colt, filly or gelding, 2 or 3 years old, not exceeding 145cms, likely to make Show Pony, to be shown in hand.
- 22 HUNTER PONY OR SHOW HUNTER PONY BROOD MARE, 3 yrs old or over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms, in foal to or with her own foal at foot by a Pony Stallion not exceeding 153cms with Stud Book qualification as set out below. Pony Stallion qualification: (a) Weatherby's including pure bred Arabs (b) Arab Stud Book or Anglo Arab Stud Book (c) Part-bred Arab Stud Register (d) Any recognised Pony Stud Book or Register.

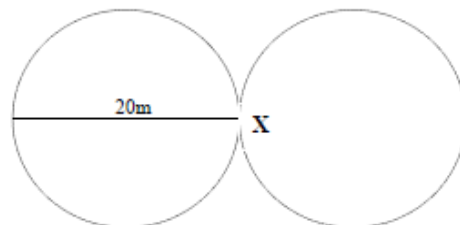

46 CPPA Ridden Championship Qualifier for registered Connemara Pony 4 yrs old and over, Open to Mares, Geldings & Stallions. To be ridden by rider under 16 on 1st January, 2017. (Stallions must be ridden by a rider over 14 yrs of age on the 1st January, 2017.)
47 RIDDEN CONNEMARA 4 years old and over. Rider over 16 years on 1st January.
48 CPPA Ridden Championship Qualifier for registered Connemara Pony 4 yrs old and over to be ridden by rider over 16 on 1st January, 2017. Open to Mares, Geldings & Stallions.

Format: This class will be judged in two phases. Flatwork Phase is followed immediately by the Jumping Phase. The jumping phase must conclude with a halt and salute. **To be ridden in a snaffle bridle.**
Ridden Phase: Total 80 marks:

| From X Medium walk 20m circle left. (4-time rhythm with correct bend, showing a degree of over tracking) | 10 marks |
| From X Working Trot 20m circle right (2-time rhythm with correct bend, showing active hind leg engagement) | 10 marks |

at X Working Canter 20m circle left(Smooth transition and correct strike off, 3 time rhythm with correct bend and balance) 10 marks

Through X 2/3 trot strides Canter half 20m circle right (smooth transition and correct strike off, 3 time rhythm with correct bend and balance) 10 marks

2nd half of circle show progressive downward transitions though trot and walk (Well defined trot and walk, maintaining contact and balance) 10 marks

At X Halt (Straight, square, immobile) 10 marks

Proceeds (by progressive transition in working canter directly to the first fence. 10 marks.

Jumping Phase: Height of fences: 90cm to 1m. 10 marks per fence. 30 marks for overall way of going and rideability. Usual deductions for fences down/refusals.
